Camps Offered in June and July		
Residential Teachers Air Camp Sponsorship	Provides funding for up to 44 teachers from across the United States or in a designated region depending on donor specifications. Includes all programs and activities, materials, overnight accommodations, and lesson plans for classroom use. Camps are in session for four days and three nights.	\$85,000
Non-Residential Teachers Air Camp Sponsorship	Provides funding for one Teachers day camp for up to 44 teachers from across the United States or in a designated region depending on donor specifications. Camps are in session for three days, eight hours a day.	\$50,000
Gifts to Support One-Day STEM Programs		
One-Day Student STEM Immersion Event	Provides funding for up to 100 students immersed in hands-on STEM activities at one location for up to 8 hours with an emphasis on developing and expanding STEM Identity while exploring applications of aviation and aeronautics content.	\$15,000
One-Day Teacher STEM Immersion Event	Provides funding for up to 40 teachers for up to 8 hours of STEM professional development ranging from one specific topic (i.e. Physics of Flight Applications) to broad STEM aviation topics. Sponsorship levels vary dependent upon classroom materials provided.	\$15,000 - \$25,000
